Training will be at St Joseph's High School Gymnasium commencing Week 3, Term 3. Access to the gym is via the Church Street entrance to the school. Please drop your child to the teacher at the gym at 7:30 am and a teacher will escort the children back to school after training.

Students may come to training in their sports uniform and stay in it for the remainder of the day.

Reminders:

- It is the responsibility of parents and carers to supervise, organise accommodation and transport or arranging transport for their child to and from a venue on the weekend of the Basketball Challenge.
- Accommodation in Goulburn may be difficult to find. We strongly suggest that all families start looking for accommodation within the coming week.
